The Scholarship Program

International scholarships of \$6,000 each are awarded annually to as many as 30 Delta Kappa Gamma members. The scholarship program achieves several of the Society's Seven Purposes.

Purpose Two

To honor women who have given or who evidence a potential for distinctive service in any field of education.

Purpose Three

To advance the professional interest and position of women in education.

Purpose Five

To endow scholarships to aid outstanding women educators in pursuing graduate study....

Purpose Six

To stimulate the personal and professional growth of members and encourage their participation in appropriate programs of action.

In addition to the international scholarships, many state organizations and some chapters have scholarship funds established to assist members in pursuing graduate study. Recipients of these scholarships also may apply for international scholarships.

During 2009-2010 state organizations and chapters provided approximately \$350,000 in scholarships to 690 members. At the international level, the Society provided \$138,000 for scholarships during 2010-2011 and \$156,000 during 2011-2012.

Who should apply?

To qualify for a scholarship at the international level, the applicant must:

-  **Be an active member of the Society** for a minimum of three years at the time of application.
-  **Have completed a bachelor's degree** or equivalent.
-  **Be accepted and enrolled in a graduate program** of a nationally accredited institution of higher education, preferably pursuing a doctoral degree.
-  **Provide evidence of excellence in scholarship and service to the community.**
-  **Be a first-time recipient** of an international scholarship
-International Standing Rule 13.62

How to apply

Instructions for applying are as follows:

- Complete current application form.**
- Request appropriate transcripts.**
- Obtain status of program documentation.**
- Secure letters of recommendation.**
- Application must be received as an e-mail attachment at Headquarters by February 1.**
