► What is it?

Geocaching is a high-tech treasure hunting game played throughout the world by adventure seekers equipped with GPS devices. The basic idea is to locate hidden containers, called geocaches, outdoors and then share your experiences online. Geocaching is enjoyed by people from all age groups, with a strong sense of community and support for the environment.



Easy Steps...

- Register for a free account at www.geocaching.com
- Click "Hide and Seek a Cache"
- Enter your postal code and click "search"
- Choose any geocache from the list and click on the name
- Enter the coordinates of the geocache into your GPS device
- Use your GPS device to help you find the hidden treasure
- Sign the logbook and return the cache to its original state
- Returning home, log the cache on the website www.geocaching.com
