ALASKAN GLACIER CRUISE

Seattle, Washington | 2 nights

Day 1: Arrival in Seattle

Included meals: Dinner

Welcome to Seattle! Transfer to your hotel and get settled in. Later, meet your group at tonight's welcome dinner.

Day 2: Sightseeing tour of Seattle

Included meals: Breakfast

Get to know Seattle, the largest city in the Pacific Northwest, on a guided sightseeing tour.

- Enter the iconic Space Needle, which served as the centerpiece for the 1962 World's Fair
- Stay on the lookout for salmon making their way up the fish ladder at Ballard Locks
- Pass by the University of Washington's sprawling campus
- End at Pike Place Market, most famous for its seafood-throwing fishmongers

Celebrity Solstice Cruise | 7 nights

Day 3: Transfer to port

Included meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

After a free morning in the city, transfer to the Port of Seattle to board your cruise ship and embark on your Alaskan voyage.

Day 4: Day at sea

Included meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Spend a full day at sea enjoying the ship's amenities, relaxing on deck or taking in the spectacular scenery.

Day 5: Ketchikan

- Pass through Tracy Arm, a 20-mile fjord through a granite canyon lined with waterfalls, icebergs and mountain peaks
- Gaze up at the Sawyer Glacier, one of the bluest and most beautiful in Alaska
- Sail into the capital city of Juneau, whose history celebrates the gold rush of the late 1800s

Day 7: Skagaway & the Inside Passage

Your next port of call is Skagaway, the starting point for prospectors during the Klondike gold rush of the late 1800s. Enjoy a free day here before cruising through the Inside Passage, a patchwork of waterways along the Alaska Panhandle.

Day 8: Day at sea

Spend the day on the open water, cruising through more breathtaking scenery. Keep an eye out for humpback, gray, minke, fin and orca whales breaching in the waves.

Day 9: Victoria

Arrive in Victoria, a city known for having the most beautiful gardens and mildest weather in Canada. Spend the evening exploring the Butchart Gardens, Inner Harbor or Parliament Building.
