San Francisco | 2 NIGHTS

Day 1: Arrival in San Francisco

Included meals: dinner

Napa Valley | 2 NIGHTS

Day 3: Napa Valley via Tomales Bay & Sonoma Valley

Included meals: breakfast

South Bay Region | 1 NIGHT

Day 5: South Bay Region via Berkeley

Day 2: Alcatraz Island | \$49* (4 hours, departs in the afternoon)

Embark on a short ferry ride from the Embarcadero Pier for an up-close look at the infamous “inescapable” federal penitentiary at Alcatraz Island. Enjoy a self-guided audio tour of this iconic American landmark and uncover its intriguing history, including details of the great 1962 escape. *This excursion requires advance reservation and must be booked by 20 days prior to departure.*
